



HOLIDAY INFORMATION LEAFLET

About the Funclub

Funclubs Ltd provides before and after school care for children attending St Peters, Rossett Acre, Oatlands and Pannal primary schools. All the Funclubs come together during the school holidays to offer school holiday care for children from any school between the ages of 4 to 11 years old.

Our Aim

- To provide a fun, caring, happy, stimulating and safe environment for children and staff, before and after school and during school holidays.
- To offer a wide and interesting range of different activities which will allow children to use their energies constructively, to learn and to relax when needed.
- To provide parents with a stress-free, reliable, open and honest service, with as much flexibility as possible.
- To work with the school towards mutual goals and co-operate with any special arrangements wherever possible.

It is our policy to help all children to develop a positive self-image, confidence and independence together with a respect and understanding of other children and adults, regardless of their colour, race, religion, special needs or gender.

Highly motivated and qualified staff

The Funclub is run by a fully qualified management team, made up of the managers from all four Funclubs, together with a team of enthusiastic and caring staff. All staff are cleared by the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) and OFSTED to work with children.

Hours 7.30am to 6.00pm

Please check each holiday for dates as training days vary between schools. Funclub is closed on bank holidays and the period between Christmas and New Year.



Provisions (Food & Drink)

In the morning we provide a drink, fruit, toast and cereals, not to replace breakfast, but as a little extra for children who arrive early.

For lunch children are asked to bring a healthy packed lunch from home. (please note we have a no nuts policy)

Around 4pm we provide a healthy light snack with salad or fruit; this is not to replace an evening meal but to provide a snack for hungry children.

What we do

Holidays are carefully planned in advance to ensure fun, varied care with at least two or three outings each week.

We offer a core selection of activities which includes: loads of varied arts and crafts, puppet shows, dressing up and role play, construction, model making, reading, music, quizzes, jigsaws and games. We encourage lots of outdoor time too, with football, cricket, parachute games, skipping, bat and ball games, obstacle races and other physical activities.

Alongside this we also do topic days taking suggestions from the children and cultural events i.e Easter, Christmas, Chinese New Year, Divali and team challenges such as master chef, bake off and young apprentice. We also put on drama and dance workshops, Funclubs got talent shows and have karaoke, quiz show games and party days.

Outings

We like to go out off the school site regularly to make the holidays even more varied and fun. For this we often go by foot but also use public transport and coaches. Examples of outings would be play parks, Valley Gardens, Cinema, Knaresborough, woodland walks and adventure trails. We also travel further afield during the summer months to the seaside, farm parks and to various other exciting locations by coach.

What you need to know

We want to have loads of fun in the holidays and send your children home at the end of the day happy and totally exhausted, in order for this to happen we are asking that you follow these few requests.

No electronics or toys

Nothing with a camera is to be brought or used at Funclub. We don't want any of your child's precious items getting lost or broken, there is loads to do here so no need for toys from home.



Suitable clothing for the trip and weather

With the great British weather and the fact that we like to have fun sometimes getting muddy please don't come in your best clothes!

Please bring wellies or good walking boots/shoes

Waterproofs and warm layers of clothing

Full spare change of clothes (just in-case)

Arrive on time

We want to go out and pack in as much fun as possible to each and everyday, so please arrive by 9am and stay until 3pm so we can make the most of the time we have. If you arrive after 9.30am we may have left the premises so you will have to give us a call and catch us up!

During the summer holiday we go on a few full day trips further afield, on these days please arrive by 8.15am and stay until 5.15pm.

Fees from September 2015

Holiday part day (9.00am - 3.00pm) £22.50

Holiday full day (7.30am - 6.00pm) £27.50

A 10% discount is available for siblings attending the same session as their full paying brother or sister.

Late collection fees apply if you fail to collect your child within the booked time: £10.00 after 6.00pm then an additional £5.00 per 15mins after 6:30pm.

Admissions

A holiday booking form must be used in order to request a holiday session, payment must be received before the session is confirmed. Holiday sessions are non-refundable but maybe swapped to different days in the same holiday if there is availability. Bookings can be made via the email address or phone number detailed below.

Payments

Dropping-off and collecting your child

If any person other than the usual carer is collecting your child we must be informed beforehand. The person collecting must be known to the child and will be asked to provide identification or a password.

Please note that our insurance does not cover your child before 7.30am or after 6pm. Children must not be dropped off before this time, or collected later than 6pm.

Registration

The Fun Club is registered with OFSTED on the Early Years Register, reference EY 47 58 27. We are members of the 4children Network.

Complaints Procedure

If you have any cause for concern you should in the first instance take it up with the Funclub Manager. We would always hope that any concerns a parent/carer may have would be raised and dealt with by negotiation and discussion between parent/carer and the appropriate staff at the time of occurrence.

However, should the issue remain unresolved then the Funclub Manager should be contacted again formally either verbally or in writing. The manager will then investigate the complaint and try to resolve the issue speedily and appropriately contacting and informing all those involved.
